ESSENTIAL MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Education: Completion of a Baccalaureate Degree in Nursing Science (BScN) is preferred.

Additional Certification:

- CPR certification within the last 12 months is essential.
- Current Canadian Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Certification (Canadian Nurses Association) would be an asset.
- Certification in Infection Control or Occupational Health would be an asset.

Professional Affiliation: Current Registration with the College of Nurses of Ontario

Experience:

Recent experience in infection prevention and control measures in the context of a pandemic, as well as experience working with individuals with mental illness is essential.

In addition, the following work experience would be an asset:

- Minimum of 3 years relevant working experience
- Working with vulnerable individuals, specifically individuals who are homeless, who have substance use disorders, and/or who have been in conflict with the law
- Administering intramuscular injections, and collecting specimens for diagnostic testing
- Designing and presenting both virtual and face-to-face PPE education and practice sessions to staff to minimize the risk of infectious diseases and outbreaks
- Leading and managing the implementation, maintenance, surveillance and evaluation of infection prevention and control practices at CMHA Ottawa

Knowledge:

- Knowledge of current infection control guidelines and best practices for the prevention and control of COVID-19
- Knowledge of mental illness from a bio-psychosocial perspective, knowledge of substance use disorders and treatments
- Knowledge of current mental health and nursing policy, legislation and regulation
- Knowledge of health issues and of social issues associated with psychiatric illness, medications, poverty, and the impact of mental illness on functional capacity

Skills:

- Ability to establish positive and supportive relationships with clients and staff
- Enthusiasm in giving presentations to groups of staff and clients on a regular basis
- Ability to respond appropriately to crisis situations, including suicide interventions
- Ability to work independently in a non-structured environment, including the ability to work flexible hours and the ability to work safely without onsite supervision
- Ability to liaise and report to internal committees such as the Joint Health and Safety Committee, as well as external agencies and stakeholders
- Demonstrates time management skills, confidentiality, and the ability to work according to the College of Nurses of Ontario Standards

 Proficiency in a Microsoft Office suite environment, video conferencing, maintaining electronic client files, and fulfilling Ministry reporting requirements

Language:

• English essential. Bilingual (French/English) preferred.
